#### 1. BERNIE Sander Wins TIME 100 Reader's Poll

- Democratic presidential hopeful Bernie Sanders has won Time magazine's readers' poll of the world's 100 most influential people, garnering more than three times as many votes as his rival Hillary Clinton.

#### 2. Nauru Becomes 189<sup>th</sup> Member of IMF, World Bank

- The Republic of Nauru, a tiny South Pacific island nation in Pacific Ocean became the 189th member of the International Monetary Fund (IMF) and World Bank.

#### 3. Maharashtra Gov become first to bring law against Social boycott & launched Mission Drinking Water

The Maharashtra Assembly led by Devendra Fadnavis passed the Prohibition of Social Boycott Bill 2016 to becoming the first State to enact such a law.

- He also launched the 'Mission Drinking Water' to conquer water crisis.

#### 4. PM MODI Launched Gram Uday Se Bharat Uday Abhiyan

- PM Narendra Modi today launched Gram Uday Se Bharat Uday Abhiyan on 125th birth anniversary of Dr. BhimRaoAmbedkar at Mhow, Madhya Pradesh.

#### 5. India Ranks 44<sup>th</sup> in 2016 Global Connectivity Index

- India ranked 44th among 50 different countries in the 2016 Global Connectivity Index (GCI) report compiled by Chinese telecom giant Huawei. United States has topped the index, Singapore ranks second and Sweden ranks third in the list.

#### 6. Vijay Shekhar Sharma appointed chairman of IAMAI Payment banks group

- Industry body Internet and Mobile Association of India, has appointed Paytm founder Vijay Shekhar Sharma, chairman of its the newly formed payments banks group.

#### 7. UN Observes birth anniversary of Dr. Ambedkar for first time.

- For the first time, United Nations observed the birth anniversary of Dr. BR Ambedkar.

#### 8. Kerala Celebrates harvest festival, Vishu.

- People in Kerala are celebrating the harvest festival, Vishu. Devotees across the state are visiting temples, performing special pujas and exchanging gifts to mark the occasion.

#### 9. Sushila Karki: First Female Chief Justice of Nepal's Supreme Court

- Sushila Karki has become the first female acting Chief Justice of Nepal's Supreme Court ending the male domination in higher posts in the judiciary. She replaced Kalyan Shrestha.

#### 10. India world's largest remittance recipient in 2015: World Bank

According to the World Bank India named as the world's largest remittance recipient in 2015 despite experiencing a \$ 1 billion drop from the previous year, the first decline in its remittances since 2009.

- India reserved its top spot in 2015, attracting about \$69 billion in remittances, down from \$70 billion in 2014, the World Bank in its annual report 'Migration and Development Brief'.

#### 11. BSNL to launch data sharing service facility for users across India

BSNL to launch data sharing facility for pre-paid customers across the country. It will allow four users to share data among themselves. No charges will be levied for availing this facility.

- Currently, the company has introduced a special tariff voucher (STV) for this service in south zone. The STV allows sharing of data among a group of people.

### 12. Government reconstitutes IGNC board; Ram Bahadur Rai appointed as Chairman

- About 8 million tourists visited Andhra Pradesh in 2015, a 30% increase over the previous year, according to the state government. Of these, 237,000 were foreign tourists mainly from Southeast Asian countries such as Singapore, Malaysia and West Asia.
- The celebrity couples were prepared to take up the role of brand ambassadors for the tourism of Amravati and the rest of the state.
