

❖ International Translation Day

- The International Translation Day is being observed on 30 September across the world.
- The theme of International Translation Day 2022 is "A World Without Barriers."
- Established by the International Federation of Translators (FIT), the annual celebration of the International Translation Day is an opportunity to pay tribute to the work of translators who endeavor to make the world a slightly smaller place by breaking down language barriers.

❖ World Maritime Day

- World Maritime Day 2022 is observed globally on 30th September. The exact date of celebrating World Maritime Day is left to the individual governments but is usually celebrated during the last week in September.
- The theme for World Maritime Day 2022 is 'New technologies for greener shipping'.

❖ Vinayak Godse to be new CEO of Data Security Council of India

- Data Security Council of India (DSCI), a leading industry organisation founded by NASSCOM, promoted senior vice president Vinayak Godse and named him the organization's new CEO.

❖ Ajay Kumar Srivastava to be the next MD and CEO of Indian Overseas Bank

- The Government of India has approved the appointment of Ajay Kumar Srivastava as the Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Indian Overseas Bank for a three year term with effect from 1 January 2023.
- Ajay Kumar Srivastava is presently the Executive Director in the bank.

➤ The present MD and CEO of IOB, Partha Pratim Sengupta's tenure ends on 31 December 2022.

➤ It is a public sector bank owned by the government of India

➤ The Indian Overseas bank was founded by M. Chidambaram Chettyar in 1937.

➤ It was nationalized by the government of India in 1969.

❖ **R. Venkataramani is the new Attorney General of India**

➤ Senior advocate R. Venkataramani has been appointed as the new Attorney General (AG) of India by President Droupadi Murmu for a period of three years.

➤ The A-G is the first law officer of the Government of India and the position of the A-G is placed on a special footing. The A-G is appointed by the President of India and has the right to audience across all courts in a country.

➤ Earlier Mukul Rohatgi has refused to be the next Attorney General of India (A-G).

❖ **Ayushmann Utkrishta award 2022**

➤ Ayushmann Utkrishta Award 2022 has been given to Uttar Pradesh for adding several healthcare facilities to the health facility register. Karnataka was ranked second with 23,838 healthcare facilities.

➤ With 28728 new healthcare facilities added to the National Health Facility Register, Uttar Pradesh is the best performing state in the nation.

➤ Uttar Pradesh is the second state in the country to have opened about two crore Ayushman Bharat Health Accounts (ABHA).

❖ **Ranipur Wildlife Sanctuary approved as the fourth 'Tiger Reserve' of Uttar Pradesh**

➤ As part of its efforts to conserve tigers, the Uttar Pradesh government has approved the establishment of the first tiger reserve in Bundelkhand's Ranipur Wildlife Sanctuary.

➤ They also approved notifying Ranipur Wildlife Sanctuary under the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972.

- With this new tiger reserve, the total number of tiger reserves in UP will go up to four.
- The other three tiger reserves are: Dudhwa Tiger Reserve in Lakhimpur, Pilibhit Tiger Reserve in Pilibhit, Amangarh Tiger Reserve (a buffer zone of Corbett Tiger Reserve) in Bijnor.
- The tiger reserves of India were set up in 1973 and are governed by Project Tiger, which is administrated by the National Tiger Conservation Authority. Until now, India has a total of 53 protected areas that have been designated tiger reserves.

❖ **Odisha releases India's first tribal community-based encyclopedia**

- Odisha became the first state to publish an encyclopedia based on tribal communities. The “Encyclopedia of Tribes in Odisha” was unveiled by state chief minister Navin Patnaik on September 26, 2022.
- Tribes, as per 2011 census, account for 22.85% of the Odisha's total population. Odisha is home to third largest tribal population of India, but it is the most diverse indigenous communities found in the country.
- The 418 articles in the Encyclopedia have been published in the Adivasi journal and other publications over the last six decades.
- The chief minister inaugurated the Tribal Museum in 2001, and the second Museum in 2009.

❖ **UCO & Yes Bank tie up with Russian banks for payments**

- UCO Bank and Yes Bank have put in place arrangements with two Russian banks as India seeks to step up trade with the sanctioned nation.
- Nearly a month after it was reported that more than 15 Russian banks were in advanced talks with Indian lenders to facilitate bilateral business in their respective local currencies.
- UCO Bank has partnered with Gazprom Bank, while Yes Bank has also formed an arrangement with Russia's Petersburg Social Commercial Bank (PSCB).
