Three new archaeological sites have been discovered in Telangana

- In recent archaeological explorations in Telangana, three significant sites have been discovered, shedding light on the region's ancient history and cultural heritage.
- These discoveries, ranging from megalithic monuments to rock art sites, offer valuable insights into the life and times of ancient civilizations that once thrived in these areas.
- The site was discovered by a team comprising K P Rao and Ch Praveen Raju.


Megalithic Monuments in Dense Forest:

- One of the discoveries includes more than 200 megalithic monuments found in the dense forest and slopes of a hill.
- These monuments, believed to be dating back to around 1,000 BCE, are predominantly of the 'Dolmenoid Cists' type, characterized by squarish or rectangular shapes.

Unique Iron Age Megalithic Site:

Another significant discovery is an Iron Age megalithic site at Ooragutta near Bandala village in SS Tadvai mandal of Mulugu district.

Discovered by a team of archaeologists, this site showcases new types of monuments not found elsewhere in India, indicating a distinct architectural style and cultural practice.

Rock Art Sites at Damaratogu:

- Additionally, two new rock art sites have been discovered at Damaratogu in Gundala mandal of Bhadradri Kothagudem district.
- One of these sites, known as 'Devarlabanda Mula', exclusively depicts animals and no humans, suggesting a cultural significance possibly related to hunting or animal worship.
- ➤ The absence of weapons or domestic animals in the paintings indicates that these artworks may belong to the mesolithic age, dating anywhere between 8000 3000 BCE.

Deepika Soreng received the Asunta Lakra Award

- Deepika Soreng, an Indian Women's Hockey Team player, won the Asunta Lakra Award for Upcoming Player of the Year during the Hockey India 6th Annual Awards 2023.
- She made her debut for India in the Women's Junior Asia Cup. She helped the Indian team to win the Gold medal by scoring 7 goals in 6 matches.
- She was also a key player for the Indian team that won the Silver medal in the FIH Women's Hockey5s World Cup Oman 2024 and also named the Young Player of the Tournament.
- She travelled with the team to the 2023 FIH Junior Women's World Cup.
- The Asunta Lakra Award is a testament to Hockey India's commitment to nurturing and recognizing emerging talents within the sport.

- Recently, the Indo-Russian Education Summit was held in New Delhi. It is the largest event of its kind in the history of India-Russia bilateral relations.
- 60 Russian universities arrived at this summit from Moscow, Saint Petersburg, Siberia, Crimea, the Urals and other regions.
- The summit brought diplomats, politicians, scientists, and businessmen to one platform to explore new opportunities for cooperation in education, science and innovative technologies.

Slovenia becomes the 39th country to join the Artemis Aggrement

- Slovenia signed the Artemis Aggrement, which is a series of non-binding arrangements for outer space.
- Slovenia has affirmed its dedication to the sustainable use of space NASA welcomes Sweden to the Artemis Accords family.
- NASA and the US Department of State in 2020 announced the Artemis Aggrement. It has 39 signatories, including India and Japan.
- The Artemis Aggrement are a set of principles for cooperation in space exploration and the use of the moon, mars, comets, and asteroids for peaceful purposes.
- Artemis program is also aiming to land the first astronauts on Mars and other planets and celestial bodies.
- Swedan become 38th country to join in Artemis Accords on April 16th 2024.
- The Armetis Accords provide the important implementation of key obligations from the 1967 Outer Space Treaty.

- On 22 June 2023, Prime Minister Narendra Modi signed the Artemis Accords to make India a global space power and India became the 27th country to sign the Artemis Accords.
- Israel, Romania, Bahrain, Singapore, Colombia, France, Saudi Arabia, Rwanda, Nigeria, and the Czech Republic have joined the accords in 2022.

A new Species Clouded Tiger Cat found in Brazil's Rainforest

- A new tiger species has been recently discovered in the dense rainforests of Brazil. Named the clouded tiger cat (Leopardus pardinoides), this cat may be small but it is significant for biodiversity and conservation.
- > The discovery of the clouded tiger cat highlights the need for greater protection of wildlife and their habitats.
- The clouded tiger cat is found in the cloud forests of the southern Central American and Andean mountain chains, spanning from Costa Rica to Argentina.
- Its habitat vastly differs from that of its relatives, the northern tiger cat and the Atlantic Forest tiger cat, which live in savannas and shrublands.
- The discovery of this new species highlights the diverse range of wildlife found in the Americas and reminds us of the many surprises nature has in store.
- > The Amazon rainforest, also known as Brazil's Rainforest, is the world's largest intact forest.

- The rainforest is mostly located in Brazil, but it is also shared among eight other countries, such as Bolivia, Colombia, Ecuador, Guyana, Peru, Suriname, Venezuela, and French Guiana, an overseas territory of France.
- This forest absorbs about 25% of atmospheric carbon dioxide and produces 6% of the total oxygen so it is called as "lung" of the planet Earth.

IRDAI celebrates Sliver Jubilee on 19th April 2024

- The Insurance Regulatory Development Authority of India (IRDAI) marks its silver jubilee year on 19th April 2024, the regulator is preparing the groundwork for a number of regulatory reforms announced in March, which will only take effect from the current financial year.
- > The silver jubilee marks a major milestone in regulatory governance. It consolidates 34 regulations with six regulations.
- > The introduction of two new regulations enhances clarity and coherence in the regulatory space.
- In line with the Malhotra Committee report's recommendations, the IRDAI was set up in 1999 as an autonomous body for regulating and taking ahead the insurance industry. On April 19, 2000, it was formally established as a statutory body.

DPE granted Navaratna status to National Fertilizers Limited (NFL)

- State-owned National Fertilizers Ltd granted "Navratna" status from the Department of Public Enterprise (DPE).
- The term 'Navratna' refers to a select group of top-performing Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) that have been granted greater autonomy and financial powers by the Centre in recognition of their performance.
- National Fertilizers reported a 73% drop in consolidated net profit at 150.9 crore for the December quarter. The revenue dropped 25.2% YoY to 17,581 crore for the quarter.
- Shares of National Fertilizers Ltd ended at ¹ 97.00, down by ¹ 0.24, or 0.25% on the BSE.
- Navaratna Companies in India are a set of public sector companies which have the financial autonomy to invest up to Rs. 1000 crores without any approval from the central government.

According to S&P Global Report, SBI got 20th position in Asia-Pacific region

- Three Indian banks, SBI, HDFC Bank and ICICI Bank, have been included in the top 50 banks of the Asia-Pacific region according to a report of S&P Global Market Intelligence.
- > The list dominated by **mainland Chinese banks** has been ranked based on their assets (loans).
- Only two Indian banks, SBI and HDFC, were included in the top 50 Asia-Pacific regions based on their assets in the 2022 list.
- This year, ICICI Bank was also included in the list. The aggregate assets of these three top Indian lenders rose sharply by 50.5 percent to \$1.51 trillion in 2023.
- India's largest commercial bank, State Bank of India, was the top-ranked bank in the 2023 list.
- The government-owned SBI improved its ranking from 20 in 2023 to 21 in 2022. In 2023, SBI's assets increased to \$780.05 billion.
- India's largest private sector bank, HDFC Bank, was the second-highestranked Indian bank in 2023. In 2022, it was ranked 46, while in 2023, it jumped to 33.

- The main reason for HDFC Bank's rank jump was the merger of the Housing Development Finance Corporation (HDFC) with HDFC Bank in 2023. HDFC Bank's assets jumped to \$464.34 billion in 2023.
- The second largest private sector bank in India, ICICI Bank, was included for the first time on the list of the top 50 Asia Pacific banks. ICICI Bank was ranked 48th.
- The total assets of Industrial and Commercial Bank of China stood at \$6.30 trillion in 2023, more than eight times of India's largest lender SBI.

Chinese Banks Dominate the List

- > Out of the **top 10 banks** in the Asia -Pacific region, **6 were Chinese banks**.
- Industrial and Commercial Bank of China Ltd., the world's largest bank, remained the largest bank in the region at the end of 2023.
- ➢ In second place was the Agricultural Bank of China Limited.
- ➢ In third place was the China Construction Bank Corporation.
- According to the S&P report, the top four Chinese banks' assets grew by 10.2 per cent to \$21.91 trillion in 2023, with Agricultural Bank showing the biggest growth at 14.3 per cent.
- The Japanese and South Korean banks suffered the biggest declines in the annual ranking. The combined assets of Japanese lenders fell by 2.5 per cent to \$10.53 trillion in 2023.
- > The combined assets of the South Korean Bank declined by 0.9 per cent compared to last year to \$2.66 trillion in 2023

Indian Navy conducts extensive exercise 'Poorvi Leher' on East Coast


- The Indian Navy carried out an extensive exercise along the East Coast as part of efforts to check its preparedness to meet any maritime security challenges.
- > The exercise 'Poorvi Leher' witnessed participation of ships, submarines, aircraft and special naval forces.
- The Indian Navy conducted Exercise Poorvi Lehar on East Coast under the Operational Control of the Flag Officer Commanding-in-Chief, Eastern Naval Command.
- The exercise was conducted in multiple phases, including combat training in a realistic scenario during the tactical phase and successful conduct of various firings during the weapon phase, towards reaffirming the Indian Navy's capability to deliver ordnance on target
- The exercise also witnessed participation of assets from IAF, Andaman and Nicobar Command and Coast Guard indicating a very high degree of interoperability amongst the Services.

Tamil Nadu is the top state in electronics exports with record\$9.6 billion in FY23-24

- The southern state Tamil Nadu has become the top state in terms of electronic goods exports in the financial year 2023-24, surpassing Karnataka and Uttar Pradesh.
- > The state posted a **78 per cent increase** in exports from **\$5.37 billion** in **2022-23** to **\$9.56 billion** in **2023-24**.
- One major reason for this is the 'China Plus One' strategy adopted by global majors like Apple. As a result, its contractors such as Foxconn and Pegatron, along with suppliers like Tata Electronics and Salcomp, have contributed to the rise of Tamil Nadu as the country's electronic hub last year.
- Karnataka became the number two exporting state with \$4.62 billion, contributing to 16 per cent of the national exports, followed by Uttar Pradesh with \$4.46 billion worth of exports and 15 per cent of the national share.
- The other top states in the list are Maharashtra (\$3.09 billion), Gujarat (\$2.75 billion), Delhi (\$1.51 billion), Haryana (\$698.3 million), and Telangana (\$610.62 million).

IRDAI abolished the age limit for individuals buying health insurance policies

- The IRDAI has removed the age limit of 65 years for individuals buying health insurance policies to expand the market and foster adequate protection from healthcare expenses.
- With the recent amendment, which has been effective from April 1, anyone, regardless of age, is eligible to buy a new health insurance policy.
- > It marks a significant change from the old rules that stopped people from getting full coverage.
- ➢ It will ensure adequate protection against unforeseen medical expenses.
- As per the IRDAI, insurers may design products specifically for senior citizens, students, children, maternity, and any other group.
- Insurers cannot deny coverage to individuals with serious medical issues such as cancer, heart or kidney failure, and AIDS.
