- ➤ World Laughter Day is celebrated to raise awareness about laughter and its many healing benefits.
- Laughter decreases the cortisol level in the brain, which affects positively on the body.

## RBI Approves Appointment of Sanjeev Nautiyal as Next MD & CEO of Ujjivan SFB

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) approved the appointment of Sanjeev Nautiyal as the managing director & CEO of Ujjivan Small Finance Bank from July 1, 2024 for a period of 3 years.
- > Sanjeev Nautiyal will be succeeding Ittira Davis, who has been serving as the MD & CEO since 2018.
- In his 36 years in banking, he has served as the **Deputy Managing Director** (Financial Inclusion & Micro Markets) in **State Bank of India (SBI)** and has also served as the **MD & CEO of SBI Life Insurance**.
- ➤ He currently is an **independent director** of **Life Insurance Corporation of India** (LIC) and acts as an advisor in various organisations.
- ➤ He will be the **third MD & CEO** of **the Ujjivan SFB bank in five years**.

### Ukraine launches world's first Al diplomat 'Victoria Shi'



- The Ukrainian Ministry of Foreign Affairs introduced Victoria Shi an AI-generated spokesperson, marking the first use of an AI avatar for official government statements in history.
- The AI spokeswoman has been created to deliver pre-pared official statements on behalf of the Ministry, and this is done using a visual avatar generated by AI.
- ➤ Victoria Shi is based on a real person Ukrainian singer and influencer Rosalie Nombre, who agreed to participate in the project.
- The Ministry asserted that Shi and Nombre are two different people and that only the AI figure gives official statements.

- Moreover, the Ministry has taken adequate measures to combat issues like deepfake.
- Each of Victoria's statements will include a unique QR code linking to the official text version on the Ministry's website.
- > Shi was created by a team called **The Game Changers** who had previously made content related to the war in Ukraine.
- > Reportedly, the main objective behind the creation of Shi was to save time and resources for diplomats.
- The adoption of AI diplomat is a significant moment as it shows the early adoption of such technologies by the government will inspire more countries to follow suit.

- The Uttarakhand Tourism Development Board and Starscapes, an astro-tourism company, have partnered to launch Nakshatra Sabha, an initiative designed to offer a comprehensive Astro Tourism experience.
- This initiative is not just about observing the stars but aims to immerse participants in various activities such as stargazing, special solar observations, astrophotography contests, and camping under the stars.
- The goal is to create an engaging platform that brings together astronomy enthusiasts, adventurers, and travellers to marvel at the wonders of the cosmos while enjoying the natural beauty of Uttarakhand.
- Nakshatra Sabha is set to commence in early June at George Everest in Mussoorie and will continue until mid-2025, featuring a series of immersive events at various locations across Uttarakhand.

## Official Anthem for ICC Men's T20 World Cup 2024 released by Sean Paul and Kes



- The International Cricket Council (ICC) has announced the release of the ICC Men's T20 World Cup 2024 Official Anthem, "Out of this World", by Grammy award winning artist Sean Paul and Soca superstar Kes.
- The release of the anthem sets the tone for what will be the biggest cricket carnival spectacle ever, with 20 international teams playing 55 matches across the West Indies and USA from 1-29 June.
- The anthem, produced by **Michael "Tano" Montano**, was launched along with the music video, which features cameos from eight-time Olympic gold-medallist Usain Bolt, cricket stars Chris Gayle, Ali Khan, Shivnarine Chanderpaul and other Caribbean personalities.

### Japan wins 2024 Men's AFC U-23 Title by defeating Uzbekistan



- ➤ Japan defeated Uzbekistan in the final to win the Men's AFC U-23 Asian Cup for the second time. Japan had earlier won the tournament title in 2016.
- ➤ Japan won by a **solitary goal** and also qualified for the **2024 Paris Olympics.** The **6th edition of AFC U-23** was held in **Qatar** from 15 April -3 May 2024. 16 teams from Asia participated in the tournament.
- > **Japan won the gold medal** with the **solitary goal** scored by substitute Yamada. While the **silver medal** was awarded to the **Uzbekistan team**.
- In the semifinal, the **Iraqi** team **defeated** the **Indonesian** team 2-1 to clinch the **bronze medal.**

- Uzbekistan also qualified for **the Paris Olympics** and has been placed in group C along with Spain, Egypt and Dominican Republic. Iraq has also qualified for the Paris Olympics.
- Fair Play Award Uzbekistan. The award was received by Uzbekistan's captain Jaloliddinov.
- **Best Goalkeeper of the Tournament** Uzbekistan's goalkeeper Nematov.
- **Top Goalscorer of the Tournament** Ali Jasim of Iraq. He scored four goals during the tournament.
- Most Valuable Player of the Tournament Japanese team captain Fujita

## India and Nigeria soon to finalise Local Currency Settlement System Agreement



- India and Nigeria have agreed to an early conclusion of the Local Currency Settlement System Agreement to boost bilateral trade between the two countries.
- Under the local currency settlement system, the trade will be settled in India's local currency and Nigerian local currency, Nigerian naira. This was decided at the 2<sup>nd</sup> session of the India-Nigeria Joint Trade Committee held in Abuja, Nigeria.
- > The Indian delegation was led by Amardeep Singh Bhatia, Additional Secretary, Department of Commerce, Ministry of Commerce and Industry.

- > Officials from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), EXIM Bank of India, and the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) also accompanied the Indian delegation.
- ➤ Both countries agreed to resolve the market access issues.
- They also agreed to further cooperation in key sectors such as Crude oil and Natural Gas, Pharmaceuticals, the Unified Payments Interface (UPI), the Power Sector and Renewable Energy, Agriculture and Food Processing, Education, Transport, Railway, Aviation, MSMEs, Development, etc.
- India established a Diplomatic House in **Lagos**, **Nigeria**, in **November 1958**; even before Nigeria gained independence, Nigeria gained independence from Britain in 1960.
- $\triangleright$  Nigeria is the  $2^{nd}$  largest trading partner of India in the African continent.

- Scar-winning Hollywood actress Meryl Streep is all set to receive the honorary Palme d'Or Award at the opening ceremony of the upcoming 77th Cannes Film Festival held annually in Cannes, France on May 14.
- The actress has also been invited as a Guest of Honour at the event, set to take place on May 14 at the **Grand Theatre Lumiere**, **France**.
- This will mark her first trip to Cannes, 35 years after she won the Best Actress Award for A Cry in the Dark in 1989.
- Previous recipients of the **Cannes honorary Palme d'Or** include Jeanne Moreau, Marco Bellocchio, Catherine Deneuve, Jean-Pierre Leaud, Jane Fonda, Agnes Varda, Forest Whitaker, and Jodie Foster.



## Flying Wedge Defence and Aerospace unveiled FWD-200B, India's First Indigenous Bomber UAV



- India's first indigenous bomber UAV aircraft- FWD-200B developed by Flying Wedge Defence, one of the pioneers in India's defence and aerospace technology sector.
- The FWD-200B has a payload capacity of 100 kgs and is classified as a MALE Unmanned Combat Aerial Vehicle (medium-altitude, long-endurance).
- The Unmanned Aerial System (UAS) consists of optical surveillance payloads and is integrated with missile-like weapons for precision air strikes.
- ➤ While having a max speed of **200 kts/370 kmph**, it has an endurance capacity of **12-20 hours**.


- The Flying Wedge Defence's state-of-the-art manufacturing unit where the FWD-200B was meticulously crafted, is over 12000 sq.ft built on 1.5 acre land and is located at Electronic City.
- The company aims to position India as a global drone manufacturing and technology hub while equipping the nation with the right air defence resources and enhancing national security.
- For over 15 years, India's pursuit of combat unmanned aircraft remained a distant dream.
- ➤ The cost of **Rs 250 crores** indigenous **FWD-200B** built with state-of-the-art technology and manufactured in India.

### Largest ever global delegation to witness India's General Election



- As a beacon of electoral integrity and transparency, the Election Commission of India exemplifies its commitment to conduct general elections of the highest standards, offering a golden bridge for global **Election Management Bodies** (**EMBs**) to witness democratic excellence first-hand.
- The Election Commission of India continues fostering international cooperation by **organising the Election Visitors' Programme (IEVP)** during the ongoing Lok Sabha Elections 2024.
- The event will be a first in terms of the scale and magnitude of participation.

- ➤ 75 delegates representing various EMBs and organisations from 23 countries namely Bhutan, Mongolia, Australia, Madagascar, Fiji, Kyrgyz Republic, Russia, Moldova, Tunisia, Seychelles, Cambodia, Nepal, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Zimbabwe, Bangladesh, Kazakhstan, Georgia, Chile, Uzbekistan, Maldives, Papua New Guinea and Namibia will take part in the event.
- Members from the International Foundation for Electoral Systems (IFES), and media teams from **Bhutan and Israel** will also participate.
- The program seeks to familiarise **foreign Election Management Bodies (EMBs)** with the nuances of India's electoral system as well as the best practices used by the largest democracy in the world.
- Chief Election Commissioner Shri Rajiv Kumar, Election Commissioner Shri Gyanesh Kumar and Dr. Sukhbir Singh Sandhu will address the delegates on the 5th of May 2024.
- Thereafter, the delegates will embark on visits to six states-Maharashtra, Goa, Gujarat, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, and Uttar Pradesh-in small groups to observe polls and related preparedness in various constituencies. The programme will end on the 9th of May, 2024.

## Maharashtra government will translocate a few tigers to the Sahyadri Reserve to increase the population

- The Maharashtra Forest Department has decided to transfer a few tigers from the Tadoba-Andhari Tiger Reserve (TATR) in Chandrapur to the Sahyadri Tiger Reserve.
- ➤ The translocation plan was approved by the National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) in October 2023.
- In the initial phase, a male tiger or a pair of male and female tigers would be translocated to Sahyadri Tiger Reserve.
- > The Sahyadri Tiger Reserve (STR) is one of **only five tiger reserves** with **zero tigers.**
- ➤ Kaval in Telangana, Kamlang in Arunachal Pradesh, Dampa in Mizoram, and Satkosia in Odisha are the other Tiger Reserves with Zero Tigers.
- > The main aim of the translocation of tigers is to increase the population of tigers in the northern Western Ghats forests.

Sahyadri Tiger Reserve is spread over 1,165 sq km and was notified in 2010 by merging Chandoli National Park

and Koyna Wildlife Sanctuary.

### China secured a remarkable victory in the finals of the Thomas and Uber Cup



- ➤ The Chinese men's team clinched their 11<sup>th</sup> Thomas Cup with a 3-1 win by defeating Indonesia.
- China's **He Ji Ting, and Ren Xiang Yu** defeated **Indonesia's Muhammad Shohibul Fikri and Bagas Maulana** in the finals.
- ➤ China had won their **first Thomas Cup** by defeating **Japan in 2018.**
- ➤ The Chinese women's team has also lifted their 16<sup>th</sup> Uber Cup title by defeating Indonesia in the final by 3-0.

- ➤ **He Bingjiao's** thrilling three-set win against **Ester Nurumi Tri Wardoyo** sealed a perfect 24-0 tournament match record for the Chinese women.
- > In 2014, India successfully hosted the Thomas and Uber Cup finals in New Delhi.

### ICC Women's T20 World Cup will be held in Bangladesh



- The Indian cricket team will clash against arch-rivals Pakistan on October 6 in the Ninth edition of ICC Women's T20 World Cup 2024, scheduled in Bangladesh from October 3<sup>rd</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup>.
- The International Cricket Council (ICC) announced the draws, groups and the full Women's T20 World Cup 2024 schedule
- The best 10 women's cricket teams from around the world will play for the title this year.

Group A Qualifier 1: Australia, India, New Zealand, Pakistan

Group B Qualifier 2: Bangladesh, England, South Africa, West Indies

- ➤ Qualifiers 1 and 2 will emerge from the ongoing ICC Women's T20 World Cup Qualifiers in Abu Dhabi, UAE.
- The top two teams from the tournament who make the final on **May 7<sup>th</sup>** will claim the last two spots in the ICC Women's T20 World Cup 2024.
