

- ➤ World Athletics Day 2024 is celebrated every year on May 7th.
- This Day is observed to raise awareness about Athletics. This day was launched to honor the sportsperson who has the responsibility to pride the nation.

- This day was first observed in 1996 and it was launched by International Amateur Athletic Federation (IAAF)
 President Primo Nebiolo.

- ➤ The World Athletics Federation and IAAF organized sports events in all schools and colleges every year.
- ➤ The **IAAF** was founded in **1912** to organize various sports events and athletics.
- In 2001, the name of the International Amateur Athletic Federation (IAAF) was changed to the International Association of Athletics Federations. And in 2019, the name was again changed to World Athletics.

Manipur Governor inaugurates 'School on Wheels' for displaced students



- Manipur governor Anusuiya Uikey inaugurated a 'School on Wheels' for children displaced by the year-long ethnic strife in the state, at Bal Vidya Mandir Complex Palace Complex in Imphal East district.
- The School on Wheels, an initiative of **Vidya Bharati Shiksha Vikash Samiti, Manipur**, aims to reach out to the violence-affected students putting up in relief camps in the state.
- As a part of the initiative, a school bus equipped with library, computers and sports items will travel to relief camps at different locations in the state, along with a teacher.

Koothandavar Festival or Koovagam festival begins in Tamil Nadu

- **Koothandavar festival or Koovagam festival at Koovagam** in **Tamil Nadu** is an annual gathering of **transgender women**.
- In the **Tamil month of Chithirai** (mid-April to mid-May), tens of thousands of transgender women gather for an 18-day-long festival, with evocative ceremonies on the **last two days.**
- Fransgender women dress as brides on the 17th day, and the priests of Koothandavar temple tie thaali for them.
- > On the last day, parts of the Koothandavar idol is brought from various parts of Tamil Nadu and assembled before being taken on a chariot.
- Transgender women gather and perform the kummi dance as the chariot moves. The crowds then travel a couple of kilometres the Natham, where the priests break the transgender women's bangles and cut the thaali.
- Lord Koothandavar, their spouse, has passed away, and they weep in sorrow. The transgender women rub off the kungumam and dress in a white sari.
- > The focal point of the festival, Lord Aravan's sacrificial ritual.

- ➤ Hill had played the role of Captain Edward Smith in Titanic and of King Théoden in the Lord of the Rings trilogy.

India and Ghana agree for operationalization of UPI on Ghana interbank systems



- India and Ghana are working to link their payment systems Unified Payments Interface (UPI) and Ghana Interbank Payment and Settlement Systems (GHIPSS) respectively to permit users to make instant, low-cost fund transfers on a reciprocal basis.
- The two countries have also discussed on Digital transformation Solutions; Local Currency Settlement System and the opportunities offered by African Continental Free Trade Agreement (AfCFTA).
- They agreed to work expeditiously towards the operationalization of NPCI's (National Payments Corporation of India) UPI on Ghana's GHIPSS within a period of 6 months.

- This MOU is done in the visit of a seven-member Indian delegation led by Additional Secretary in the Department of Commerce Amardeep Singh Bhatia to Accra, Ghana.
- The bilateral trade between India and the West African nation Ghana has increased to USD 2.87 billion in 2022-23 from USD 2.6 billion in 2021-22.
- The trade gap is in the favour of Ghana mainly due to imports of gold by India which accounts for nearly 80 per cent of total imports from Ghana.
- ➤ NPCI International has recently announced its partnership with Bank of Namibia to support them in developing a UPI-like real-time payment system in the African nation.
- India's UPI has already reached countries including Singapore and the UAE and Nigeria

Jose Raul Mulino elected as President of the Republic of Panama

- > José Raúl Mulino has won Panama's presidential election after three of his nearest rivals conceded defeat.
- The 64-year-old former security minister has secured nearly 35% of the counted votes, with more than 92% of the votes counted.
- He replaced Laurentino Cortizo.
- > José Raúl Mulino is a Panamanian lawyer, diplomat and politician.

Panama's **economic growth** is projected to reach **2.5% in 2024**, while grappling with high income inequality and an

unemployment rate hovering around 10%.

Chinese road construction in Shaksgam Valley



- India expresses concern over recent Chinese road construction activities in the Shaksgam Valley in the trans-Karakoram tract of Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK), a territory ceded by Pakistan to China in 1963.
- The **5180 square kilometers** of Indian territory in the **Shaksgam Valley** was illegally ceded by **Pakistan to China in 1963**.
- The road is to be a part of an alignment that aims to link **the Karakoram Highway** to the **Upper Shaksgam Valley**, which borders the Siachen Glacier.
- This new road passes through the 16333 feet Aghil Pass and could provide an alternative route to the Karakoram Pass via Upper Shaksgam and further to the Khunjerab Pass in the Northern Areas of Occupied Jammu and Kashmir.

- The construction of this road is a matter of serious concern for India. If China extends the road to the Upper Shaksgam Valley, it would pose a dual threat to Indian positions on the Siachen Glacier from both Pakistan in the South and China in the North.
- The Siachen glacier, a vital piece of Indian territory, is situated adjacent to the Shaksgam Valley and holds strategic importance, particularly amidst the 2020 standoff between Indian and Chinese troops in eastern Ladakh.
- China's extensive military build-up along the Line of Actual Control, especially in eastern Ladakh, poses threats to Indian positions in regions like Depsang and Daulat Beg Oldie.



Mindgrove and Peak XV launches India's first Commercial SoC for IoT Devices



- Peak XV Partners-backed fabless semiconductor startup Mindgrove Technologies to launch India's first commercial high-performance SoC (system on chip).
- It was named as **Secure IoT** (**Internet of things**), it is designed for **IoT devices** and will likely cost **30% less than other chips in similar segments.**
- The startup, supported by **IITM Pravartak Technologies Foundation** and incubated in the **IIT-Madras Incubation** Cell.

- The chip has had a successful **MPW tape-out** (the silicon industry term for prototyping) at the **28nm node**.
- Secure IoT is a high-performance microcontroller RTOS (real-time operating system) clocked at 700 MHZs, thus opening up arenas like traffic control systems, autonomous vehicles, medical equipment, etc.
- > It is the only Indian chip that is **commercially available in this segment.**
- The chip is designed to provide programmability, flexibility, security and superior computing power for controlling applications on a wide range of connected smart devices.
- Mindgrove was founded by **Shashwath and Sharan Srinivas J** and is backed by **Peak XV Partners**, Speciale Invest and Whiteboard Capital.

German company tests rocket powered by candle wax

- German company HyImpulse successfully launched a candle wax-powered rocket capable of carrying commercial satellites on a test suborbital flight into space for the first time.
- > The 12 metre, 2.5-tonne test rocket dubbed "SR75" lifted off in Koonibba, Australia.
- It is capable of carrying satellites weighing up to 250 kg to an altitude of up to 250 km while being fuelled by paraffin, or candle wax, and liquid oxygen.

Paraffin can be used as a cheaper and safer alternative fuel for rockets, reducing satellite transportation costs by as much as 50%.
